

BPI APPROVED 2 DAY BUILDING PERFORMANCE ANALYST

The two-day Building Analyst Certification training course is specifically designed to prepare professionals who have already successfully completed the Dunwoody Introductory and Advanced Home Energy Auditor training and who have received their Minnesota State Energy Auditor certification. FDLTCC has determined that these courses have effectively covered most of the classroom training and that participants seeking BPI Building Analyst Certification should be able to do so by attending two days of the five-day course. This two-day training will include hands-on training required to successfully pass the field test including set up and use of the blower door, combustion appliance testing, and more.

PLEASE NOTE: Field testing requires 2 hours to complete and participants will need to make arrangements with the instructor to do so. Written testing is completed on Friday afternoon, and field testing will be scheduled individually in the week following. All testing must be completed within one week of the completion of the course.

Objectives of this course:

- Introduce you to blower door testing.
- Investigate cost effective energy retrofits.
- Increase awareness of health and safety issues.
- And more!

Course includes 16 hours of combined classroom and hands-on training utilizing FDLTCC's lab homes.

Total cost of the course includes the following:

- Certification fee
- Proctored written online exam
- Proctored field test exam

Participants must pass the BPI on-line written exam with 70% passing score to qualify to take the BPI field examination. Passing both the written and field results allows participant to obtain BPI certification.
