

BPI APPROVED BUILDING ANALYST CERTIFICATION

Whether you are looking to expand your related business to include energy audit services, or want to begin the process for a new career in the industry, this hands-on, interactive course is the best place to start. Written testing is completed on Friday afternoon, and field testing will be scheduled individually in the week following. All testing must be completed within one week of the completion of the course.
